INSTRUCTIONS

For

A part-time student and-a full-time employee

- Are you employed by the Solid Waste and Recycling Management (SWRM) Industry and are either a Mid-Atlantic Chapter SWANA member in good standing at the time of application, selection and award or are you sponsored by a Mid-Atlantic Chapter SWANA member in good standing at the time of application, selection and award?
- Do you meet both of the criteria below?
 - Part-time student is a student who's taking \leq 12 credits per semester
 - Full-time employee shall be as defined by the employer (for example \geq 35 hours per week)

If the answer is a '**Yes**' to the above two questions, then provide the following to help in the evaluation of your application.

Please provide following supplemental information on a maximum of two (2) pages:

- credits to be taken in the next semester(s),
- financial need,
- financial support by the employer (as well as their educational support policy),
- why/where/how is the applicant obtaining a degree,
- how the degree will be related to the profession of SWRMI,
- What are the applicant's future plans once a degree is obtained?

If you are currently employed full-time and enrolled as a part-time college or university students who is entering the junior or senior undergraduate year and pursuing a degree in environmental science, engineering or other suitable major related to solid waste management), then the applicant shall use the corresponding **Category II** form and mark '**IIb**' on the application. A part-time student applicant working full time shall **ignore the activities section** of the said application form.

If you are currently employed full-time and are a part-time student who is entering or who is in graduate school and is pursuing a degree in environmental science, engineering or other suitable major related to the field of solid waste management), then the applicant shall use the **Category III** form and just mark '**IIIb**' on the application. A part-time student applicant working full-time shall **ignore the activities section** of the said application form.

Please note: - At the option of the Scholarship Committee, other criteria may be considered and additional information may be requested. The Scholarship Committee reserves the right to request additional information to supplement a candidate's original application. In addition, at the discretion of the Scholarship Committee, additional criteria may be considered to evaluate or differentiate between candidate applications.
